Continue to support the principle of a new nuclear power station at Sizewell C...

...recognising the significant benefit that such a development would bring

However, not yet able to fully support the specific proposals proposed at Stage 2...

... by EDF Energy as impacts not yet fully developed or evidenced.





EDE Energy Stage 3 consultation

Transport proposals

No sea based delivery strategy but retention of Beach Landing Facility

Rail-led strategy

- Limited deliveries proposed "up to 5 trains per day"
- Widespread track uplift work
- Passing Loop (Melton/Campsea Ash) & Sax track crossover
- Sizewell Halt and/or Main Site Rail Head options
- Level Crossing upgrades or closures south of Saxmundham
- Strengthening at least 6 bridges
- Overhead conveyor and new siding at Leiston
- Network Rail dependency "...higher risk..." strategy
- Theberton bypass
- Threat of increase in workforce size up to 7,900
- Increased car, bus & LGV movements
- Still high HGV dependency (225 to 450+ deliveries)

New Road-led strategy

- Very limited Rail deliveries "up to 2 trains a day"
- Increased HGV traffic movements
- Stratford & Farnham bypass
- Some Rail improvements & Sizewell Halt/new Rail Siding
- Threat to limited (07:00 23:00) HGV operations
- Freight Management Facility of A14 east of A12 junction
- Revised Yoxford roundabout and road alignment
- Other minor road "improvements"
- New Sizewell Link road incorporating Theberton bypass
- Threat of increase in workforce size up to 7,900
- Increased car, bus and LGV movements
- Very high HGV levels (375 to 750+ deliveries)

Temporary line off the Sax Branch Line into the Sizewell C site Broad support from many quarters at Stage 2 response

But some concerns; B1122 level crossing, night trains, noise...

...closure of Buckleswood Rd, air quality, farm land impacts, etc.






The Sizewell Link Proposal...




