Verge Cutting Policy Update

From Suffolk County Council Highways – 22nd June 2018

The Winter and Cyclic works team have advised that for A and B roads, Suffolk Highways carries out 2 cuts per year of the first 1.2 metre width and cutting to maintain visibility at junctions, bends and signs.

For Minor Roads (C and U), Suffolk Highways carries out 1 cut per year of the first 1.2 metre width and cutting to maintain visibility at junctions, bends and signs.

Often verges are wider than 1.2 metres and vegetation beyond this point will remain largely untouched at these locations.
